Dear Taxpayer:

Thank you for your correspondence dated July 27, 2018, about the unpaid balance for the tax periods above.

Case Closed - Currently Not Collectible

We temporarily closed your collection case for the tax periods above because we determined that you can't pay the money you owe at this time.

However, you still owe \$146,425.80 to the IRS for the tax periods above. This amount includes applicable penalties and interest calculated to Aug. 24, 2018. You'll receive annual reminder notices, and we'll continue to charge applicable penalties and interest until you pay the amount you owe in full. In addition, we'll apply your future federal or state refunds to the amount you owe.

You don't need to take any action at this time. However, you must file all future tax returns and pay any amounts you owe on time. You can also minimize additional penalties and interest by making voluntary payments towards the amount you owe. If your financial situation improves in the future, we may re-open your case and resume collection activities.

If you want to make voluntary payments, you have payment options.

We've provided a general explanation of the penalties and/or interest we may have included in the current balance due on your account.
